#### Financial Report

- Acceptance of the financial report.

#### Report from Westminster Highlands

- Board member and WH Vice President Jeffrey Lang is in the process of identifying needed maintenance demands of the buildings and will create a list of those items that need immediate attention and those that are important but have a lower priority.

#### Report from Camp Lambec

- James Benson has been diligently working to lay the ground work for a capital campaign. He is planning a tiered approach and is contacting potential donors now. The capital campaign is designated to renovate the water system at Camp Lambec. Any remaining funds will improve the buildings and facility at Lambec.
- Board Member Paul Zorzie reported that we have contracted with a general contractor and electrician to begin the mechanical work at Camp Lambec's pump-house. Work is scheduled to begin January 22<sup>nd</sup> (weather permitting). Once the mechanical work is completed, the instrumentation will be installed according to the engineer's specification. We are on target to have DEP approved water ahead of our 2018 summer programs.
- An additional bathroom must be installed in the dining hall to meet the requirements of the Erie County Health Department. Bob is planning the installation.
- The Board reviewed a "help wanted" ad which will be circulated in the area surrounding Camp Lambec. We are in need of a maintenance person that lives near Lambec and can operate the new water system and perform maintenance tasks.
