The Beaver-Butler Presbytery held its stated meeting at 6:00 P.M. Tuesday, March 28, 2023, using a Hybrid format, in-person and via Zoom. Moderator was Elder Carolyn Paulsen, Vice-Moderator Rev. Jamie Fowler; the meeting was hosted by Park Presbyterian Church, Beaver, where the Rev. Todd Allen serves as Pastor.

OPENING WORSHIP:

The Presbyters welcomed – and received the Word from – the Rev. Dr. Michael R. Wilson, Stated Clerk, Synod of the Trinity. Dr. Wilson brought greetings from the almost 900 churches in the other 15 presbyteries, consisting of nearly 120,000 brothers and sisters in Christ. He read from Ephesians 4, where the Apostle Paul begs us to "…lead a life worthy of the calling to which you have been called." Dr. Wilson spoke to those gathered about "thriving in ministry." If we are to thrive, we must walk together, and receive God's grand & glorious vision of ministry.

- Appointed Rev. Dr. Larry Maley as Moderator for North Sewickley, Ellwood City

FROM THE STATED CLERK, REV. RANDALL CLOW:
