# Presbytery Meeting Summary September 26, 2023 Stated Meeting

The Beaver-Butler Presbytery held its stated meeting at 4:00 P.M. Tuesday, September 26, 2023, using a Hybrid format, in-person and via Zoom. Moderator was Elder Carolyn Paulsen, Vice-Moderator Rev. Jamie Fowler; the meeting was hosted by the Trinity Presbyterian Church, Butler, where Carmen Shullo serves as Commissioned Pastor. The Sacrament of Communion was also celebrated.

### **OPENING WORSHIP:**

The Commissioners welcomed The Rt. Rev. Dr. Lt. Col. Bliss Divine K. Agbeko (Rtd.) from the Evangelical Presbyterian Church, Ghana. He spoke from Romans 12:4-11 – Paul compares the family of believers to various parts of the body, as well as instructions on mutual love and honor. Rev. Agbeko noted the 175-year history of the EPC Ghana, and its relationship with the PC(USA), and the Beaver-Butler and Lake Erie Presbyteries in particular. He encouraged us "...with the love of Christ to support each other."

- Received the 2024 Presbytery Meeting and Holiday Schedules
- From Ministry & Vocation (MVC): Approved the Union Congregation Agreement between Ambridge United PC and Zion's First Evangelical Lutheran Church, Ambridge

#### STATED CLERK:

Rev. Randall Clow directed the Presbyters to three **Sample Templates**, provided by the Presbytery to address recent changes in our *Book of Order*. Churches are now required to have an **Anti-Racism Policy**, a **Harassment Policy**, and a **Family Medical Leave Policy**. The Templates are available on the Presbytery website.

#### MINISTRY & VOCATION:

- The Presbyters approved a 3% increase for 2024 Terms of Call for Pastors, Certified Christian Educators, and Certified Associate Christian Educators.
- Pastors having contractual relationships with Church Sessions (as opposed to those called by Congregations) will now be called *Covenant Pastors*.
- The Presbyters approved for a First Reading a *Process to Receive New Members* (*Note: Previously ordained clergy wishing to become members of BBP*)

**PERSONNEL:** The Presbyters approved the 2024 Terms of Call for Executive Presbyter Rev. Dr. Thomas L. Harmon

#### MISSION & COMPASSION:

The Presbyters welcomed International Peacemaker Amira Barham, a Palestinian Christian. Using a number of dramatic photographs and other visuals, Amira presented a powerful and thought-provoking picture of the conditions under which the Palestinian community must live (and survive).

#### FINANCE COMMITTEE – THE PRESBYTERS:

- Approved the Per Capita Matching Program: Beaver-Butler Presbytery (BBP) will match (at the Church Session's request) 50 cents per dollar, up to the Church's assessed and remitted Synod and/or GA Per Capita, to be paid from BBP reserves (Deadline December 1, 2023).
- *Approved* the 2024 Per Capita Amount: \$32.00 per member (\$0.41 increase from 2023).
- Approved the 2024 BBP Budget (understanding that the deficit comes out of reserves).

- Approved a part-time Covenant Pastor contract between Rev. Dr. Mary Kitchen and the White Oak Springs and Faith Congregations.
