
CHURCH ELDERS AND CHURCH MONEY Inter-Presbytery Leadership Formation Workshop

ALICE training gives participants insight and response options when encountering an active shooter. ALICE (Alert, Lockdown, Information, Counter, and Evacuation) represents options for responding.

Life-threatening bleeding can happen to people injured in serious accidents or disasters. Instead of being a witness, you can become an immediate responder because you know how to STOP THE BLEED®.

Anyone interested in learning to prepare and respond to an active shooter event in a house of worship setting and to control bleeding techniques can attend.
