In 1990, Brad Smith, seminary intern at Spring Valley Presbyterian Church in Columbia, SC, led a simple prayer: "Lord, even as we enjoy the Super Bowl football game, help us be mindful of those who are without a bowl of soup to eat."

This gave birth to an idea. Why not harness the energy and enthusiasm of Super Bowl weekend to unite the nation for a higher good? Individuals and groups could collect dollars and canned



food in soup pots for those in need.

Since then, *Souper Bowl of Caring* has become a national, grass-roots, youth-inspired movement. Millions in dollars and food has been generated to benefit soup kitchens, food banks, meal programs and hunger-relief charities.

There are different ways to organize a *Souper Bowl of Caring* event. Consider organizing a Souper Bowl lunch and set out a soup pot. You or your church can donate locally or donate dollars to the *Super Bowl of Caring* organization.

PC(USA) CARBON FOOTPRINT SURVEY

Congregations, presbyteries and synods have a new opportunity to help the planet by participating in an effort to reduce the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.)'s carbon footprint.

The Presbyterian Hunger Program (PHP) is urging them to take the Energy Use and Carbon Footprint Survey, which is available online and takes just 10 to 15 minutes to fill out once the required material has been gathered.

The survey springs from action taken during the 225th General Assembly (2022) to help protect the environment by taking steps to reduce the church's carbon footprint by 25% in four years. As part of that, the Presbyterian Mission Agency was directed to conduct a survey of Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) buildings to help determine the denomination's current footprint.
