

National elections can stir up conflict, anxiety, and fear. Our churches feel these tensions too. Preachers take great care to sidestep partisan politics from the pulpit, yet still touch a nerve on one side or the other (or both).

Administrative meetings take on the tenor of point/counter-point news debates. Bible study groups wonder aloud how faithful Christians can interpret Scripture so differently. Meanwhile, concerns about election violence threaten our wider communities, as Christian imagery and language are co-opted by movements of political extremism and hatred.

How should Christian leaders respond? With inspiring lectures, strategies for preaching, and creative exploration, this conference will equip pastors and congregants to choose the way of Christ over the empires of the world.

The emerging landscape of mission, refugees, migrants, and the church in the Global South — traditionally viewed as recipients of mission goods and services—has become a major source of innovation and leadership in the founding of new worshiping communities, the provision of community services, and the work of advocacy for justice around the world.

This year's theme will highlight this paradigm shift in God's mission and examine how we can learn from our siblings in Christ on the other side of our world.

Dr. Harvey Kwiyani, Malawian theologian, director of the ACTS 11 Project: Centre for Global Witness and Human Migration at Church Mission Society, will deliver the McClure Lecture and lead our discussions with immigrant mission leaders.

Workshops will be taught by mission leaders and PTS staff and faculty.
