Presbytery Meeting Summary November 19, 2024 Stated Meeting

The Beaver-Butler Presbytery held its stated meeting at 6:00 P.M. on Tuesday, November 19, 2024, at the New Sewickley Presbyterian Church, where Rev. Beth Wierman serves as Pastor. Moderator was Rev. Jamie Fowler, Vice-Moderator was Elder Dennis Krebs.

Before the meeting, training was held for new Elder Commissioners (or anyone else wanting a refresher). Expect subsequent meetings to have similar training sessions.

ACTIONS TAKEN BY THE PRESBYTERY:

- Approved the Presbytery Meeting Minutes, September 24, 2024
- Received the Coordinating Team Minutes, October 2, 2024
- Received the Stated Clerk Report, September-October 2024
- Received the Treasurer's Report, Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss, September 30, 2024
- *Approved* the dissolution of the call between Rev. James E. Salyers and Steffin Hill, Beaver Falls, effective December 31, 2024, *if the way be clear*, with the congregation's action on November 24th.
- Approved the formation of an Administrative Commission to provide a Service of Installation for Rev. Kalyn D. Stevwing at Ohio, Aliquippa. Kalyn was also introduced to and received by the Presbyters.

STATED CLERK: Randall explained how the Presbytery will analyze and vote upon recent Amendments (and one Ecumenical Agreement) approved at the recent 226th General Assembly. The Amendments and the Agreement have been referred to relevant Committees, and those Committees will make recommendations at the upcoming January 25, 2025 meeting. Commissioners will cast their votes approving or disapproving the recommendations. Randall encouraged churches and sessions to review, discuss, and pray over the changes.

COMMITMENT TO COVENANT: Executive Presbyter Tom Harmon reviewed the challenges and successes from 2024, and highlighted plans for 2025.

GREETINGS FROM OUR ECUMENICAL PARTNER: The Presbyters welcomed Rev. Liddy Barlow, Executive Minister, Christian Associates of Southwest Pennsylvania. Christian Associates represents twenty-eight Protestant, Catholic, and Orthodox church bodies in Southwest Pennsylvania. Beaver-Butler Presbytery has been part of Christian Associates for over fifty years (Tom has been the Executive Committee President the past two years). Liddy spoke extensively about Christian Associates' ministry and outreach. She spoke about ecumenical partnerships developed in the Presbytery.

COLLABORATION, FELLOWSHIP, AND YOUTH: Presbytery Youth Leadership Connection Director Diana Spencer promoted the Presbyterian Youth Triennium, to be held in Louisville, KY July 28-31. Youth should check it out! A report was given on a recent joint ministry event in Slippery Rock.
