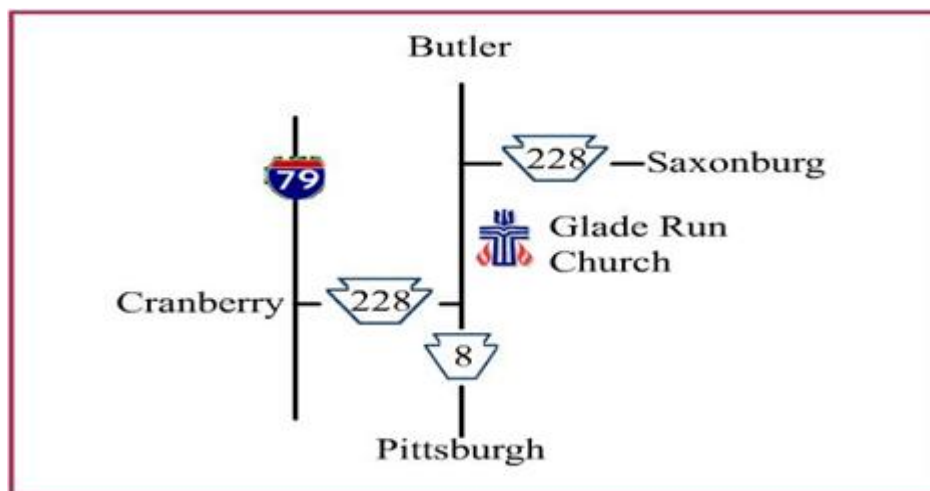
## Directions:



Glade Run is centrally located on Route 8 (Pittsburgh Road) in Middlesex Township, Valencia, Pennsylvania.

If traveling south on Route 8 from Butler or west on Route 228 from Saxonburg, the church complex is located on your left, one-half mile south of the Route 228 East and Route 8 interchange.

If traveling north on Route 8 from Pittsburgh or east on Route 228 from Cranberry, the church complex is on your right, one mile north of the Route 228 West and Route 8 interchange (or 7 miles north of the PA turnpike exit 4).

The Emma Dean Anderson Room will be set aside for prayer. It is located in the rear of the sanctuary on the left.

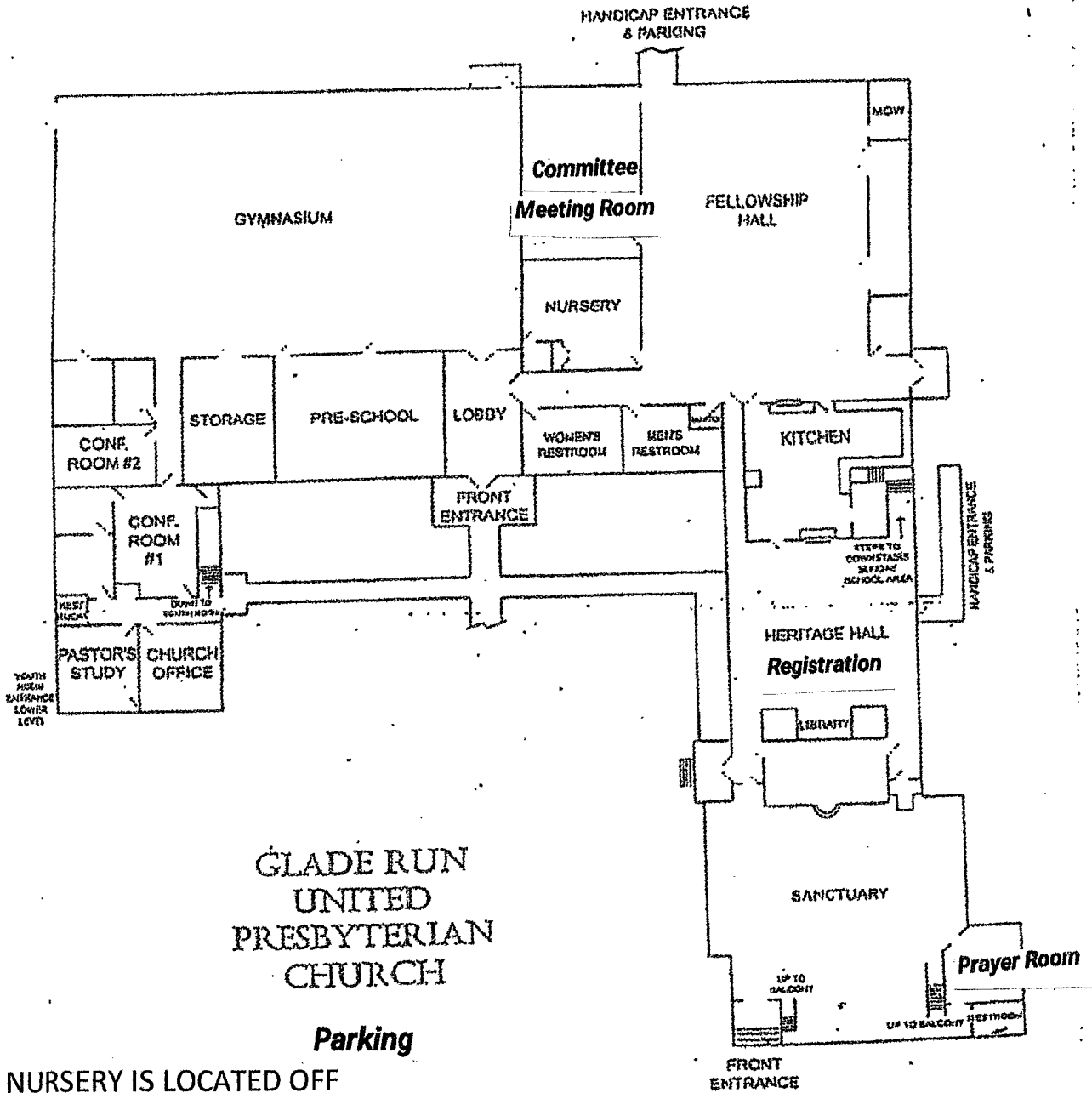

**A GATHERING OF THE CHURCHES OF BEAVER-BUTLER PRESBYTERY**  
**January 25, 2025, 10:00 AM**

The Beaver-Butler Presbytery held a stated meeting at 10:00 AM on Saturday, January 25, 2025. The meeting was held at Old Union Presbyterian Church, Mars, where Rev. Peter C. de Vries, Ph.D. serves as Pastor. The meeting was moderated by Moderator Elder Dennis Krebs and Vice-Moderator Rev. Brian Hauser.

Moderator Krebs called the meeting to order at 10:01 AM and affirmed the presence of a quorum with Stated Clerk Rev. Randall Clow.

**WELCOME, ORIENTATION, AND OPENING WORSHIP:**

Denny welcomed Minister Members, Elder Commissioners, and especially visitors attending the Annual Memorial Service. He offered condolences to those who had lost loved ones in 2024 and opened the meeting with prayer.

***ANNUAL MEMORIAL SERVICE***

**HYMN:** “It is Well With My Soul”

*(In keeping with the Old Union tradition, the Presbyters read the passage in unison...)*

**THE WORD SPOKEN:** “In Every Season of Your Life” Rev. Dr. Peter de Vries  
Peter spoke about a recent Old Union mission trip to Buckhorn, KY. The local church building was a large log cabin. Rather than meeting in the (unheated, unairconditioned) log building, the forty-three member congregation meets in the local Community Center. The day the missionaries arrived, the congregation was holding a memorial dinner for a beloved member.

The town is also the home of an addiction recovery center. Residents are invited to the weekly meal. The Old Union folks met with both a grieving community and a group of men trying to rebuild their lives. Peter compared the diversity of the community meal with the diversity of emotions present at the Presbytery meeting.

There is a season for every aspect of our lives – some seasons are more difficult than others. Where do we find ourselves this morning? God wants particular seasons for us, and sometimes we find ourselves where we don’t want to be. Where are we now? What season are we experiencing?

Regardless, God loves and protects us during ANY season. As Paul reminds us in his words from Romans, there is no place where we can go that God is not with us. Nothing can separate us from the love of Christ. The passage we read together captures this perfectly.
