Hosted by Collaboration, Fellowship and Youth


Pastors are invited to a relaxed lunch for area pastors—an opportunity to reconnect, share stories, and enjoy fellowship with those who walk a similar road.

One Year Later

A Look Back at Hurricane Helene's Devastating Impact

The Rev. Dr. Marcia Mount Shoop, pastor and head of staff at Grace Covenant Presbyterian Church in Asheville, North Carolina, pens an account detailing the church's unwavering response.

It's been a year since Hurricane Helene hit Western North Carolina. Different metrics are used after a natural disaster to measure its impact: the number of lives lost (248 recorded), the number of homes destroyed or damaged (some estimates as high as 200,000), the dollar amount of economic losses (in North Carolina alone estimates exceed \$54 billion), and how much it will cost to rebuild (some estimates exceed \$200 billion). Hurricane Helene's numbers are staggering, and they tell only a fraction of the story of how life changed that day in September 2024, exactly a year ago on Saturday [September 27].
