- 2) To provide leadership and direction to the contemporary music ministry at SMPC. In consultation with the Senior Pastor and worship team members, oversee all aspects of the contemporary music ministry and the resources needed to deliver an excellent and enriching worship experience.

Reporting Relationship: As Director of Youth Ministries, reports to the Senior Pastor and Session. As Director of Contemporary Worship, reports to Senior Pastor and Director of Music Ministry.

Youth Ministry Responsibilities:

- Develop, direct, and administer the programs for youths grades 6 through 12 with oversight by the Senior Pastor and Session
- Lead weekly youth group meetings for students grades 6 through 12
- Involve students in the ministry and life of the church
- Organize and develop a biblically and spiritually sound youth curriculum
- Provide spiritual direction and discipleship to youth
- Teach and lead annual Communicants class
- Plan, direct, and lead youth mission trips, summer and fall retreats, and youth outings and other activities that minister to the youth's need for fellowship and spiritual growth

Contemporary Worship Responsibilities:

- Coordinate all musical aspects of the 9:00 contemporary worship service
- Identify and recruit capable instrumentalists, vocalists and technicians to serve on the contemporary worship team
- Schedule instrumentalists, vocalists and technicians
- Support the Senior Pastor's vision for worship
- Select worship music that will enhance the primary message of the weekly services
- Maintain church-owned instruments and equipment and recommend upgrades and replacements to Session
- Must have skills to lead worship and ability to play either keyboard and/or guitar
