

EDUCATE A CHILD

A Grant Opportunity (Beaver-Butler Presbytery)

Background

The initiative, titled “Educate a Child, Transform the World,” (adopted by the 221st General Assembly of PCUSA), is a joint effort of Presbyterian World Mission and Compassion, Peace and Justice to join with local partners to provide quality education for children.

Opportunity

The Mission and Compassion Ministries Unit is offering to each congregation a maximum grant of \$500 to assist in the support of educational ministry. This grant is available to congregations in Beaver-Butler Presbytery that are already involved, and those congregations that want to initiate, an education ministry in their own communities as well as supporting schools and teachers in other parts of the world. Examples of ministry might be: launching or supporting a tutoring program; providing school meals and/or supplies (backpacks, teacher materials, etc.); conducting or supporting an after-school program or a preschool for community children; honoring the teachers in the congregation (better yet, in the whole local school); supporting an educational ministry in another country.
